

# What users can do with the

## EBSCO App

- Search and browse your entire *EBSCO eBooks* collection
- Place holds on popular titles
- Download titles to the app and read even when they're offline
- Sync bookmarks and recent position in the same title across mobile devices
- Customize the reading experience by adjusting font size, brightness, margins, and more
- Easily return e-books to your collection when they finish reading

## How to install and use the EBSCO App

1. Download the *EBSCO eBooks* app from Google Play or iTunes.

*You will need an Adobe ID to run the app. If you do not already have one, you can get one at this stage for FREE by clicking on the 'create an ID' link and fill in a few details.*

2. Find your library and sign in to access their collection.

*Select SEPT as the library. This will now take you to the Athens login page where you can use your SEPT Athens log in.*

3. Search and browse to find the title you're interested in.

4. Download an *EBSCO eBooks* by clicking on the "Download" link on the search result page or from within the detailed record.

*At this point you will need to create an EBSCO account. Fill in the form provided. The password requires upper and lower case letters, number and characters. It will tell you if your password is strong enough as you type it.*

5. Select your preferred checkout period and click "Checkout & Download".

6. The title automatically opens in the *EBSCO eBooks* app.

7. Begin reading the title in the app, bookmark your place for later, and return it to the library's collection when finished.
